

Privacy Notice for members of the Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation Europe Limited Pension Scheme

The trustees of the Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation Europe Limited Pension Scheme (the **Trustees** and the **Scheme**, respectively) (whose registered office is SMBC Bank International plc, 100 Liverpool Street, London, EC2M 2AT) is the “data controller” in respect of personal data processing for the administration of the Scheme.

As data controller, the Trustees hold certain personal data about you, as a Scheme member, and your dependants and beneficiaries (if any). Personal data means information that can be used to identify you as an individual. The Trustees process this data to comply with its legal obligations under the Scheme and under law, and for the purposes of its legitimate interest in properly administering the Scheme.

In processing your personal data, the Trustees may:

- pass on personal data to third parties which may include the Scheme’s sponsoring employer, professional advisers, administrator, insurance companies, counterparties to Schemes investments, those that form part of the pension dashboard “ecosystem”, regulators and Government bodies, as may be necessary or desirable for the operation of the Scheme;
- transfer your personal data outside the UK and European Economic Area (EEA) to a jurisdiction that may not offer an adequate, or equivalent, level of protection according to the laws of your home jurisdiction. However, in the event that your personal data are sent outside the UK or EEA, the Trustees will still process your personal data in accordance with the applicable data protection laws, and will take reasonable steps to ensure that your personal data are handled securely and in accordance with the Trustees’ data protection policy and long form privacy notice;
- process your sensitive personal data, where relevant – for example, health records in connection with an application for ill-health benefits under the Scheme; where the Trustees collect such data, we are required to meet additional legal requirements in relation to our processing activities; and
- retain your personal data for legitimate business reasons or to comply with applicable laws.

In certain circumstances, your personal data may be passed to the Scheme’s actuary, legal adviser and/or auditor and, where this is the case, the actuary, legal adviser and/or auditor may also be data controllers of your data.
